COVID CONFLICT ROUND 2

Dear Friends,

Since the Pandemic began it seems we've become characters in the Mad Max Film: Beyond Thunderdome or maybe the Matrix or we are all participants in the Truman Show. Either way, "we don't need another hero, we don't need to know the way home, all we want is life beyond the Pandemic." Still it drags on. And just like in Thunderdome, "two men enter one-man leaves" the fight is still on! Welcome to COVID-19 Conflict Round II.

In COVID-19 Conflict Round I in one corner was the masked fighter and in the other corner was the unmasked fighter and so we battled. 'You have to wear a mask and You can't make me wear a mask'. Or even 'if you don't wear a mask you are guilty of mass murder' and 'there is no scientific evidence masks prevent COVID infections' and on it went. Hostility grew even to the point of violence. Maybe masks are effective in some circumstances or maybe they are not. The messaging seemed to be designed to set up conflict rather than encourage harm reduction, which is usually the focus of Public Health messaging. So rather than encouraging masks "to protect yourself" it was all about protecting others. A charitable idea but it also helped create a lot of self-appointed mask enforcers. Besides if you are wearing a mask, you are protecting yourself but if you are upset that someone else is not wearing a mask, do you really believe then that the mask you are wearing is protecting you?

So now we enter Round II of COVID-19 Conflict: in one corner is the vaccinated fighter and in the other corner is the unvaccinated fighter. In its most recent updated guidance on masks, the CDC said that if you are vaccinated you should still wear a mask in most circumstances. And the reason they gave for continued use of facial couture is because some people have declined to get vaccinated. You can see the set up: people who do not get vaccinated are like people who refuse to wear masks and are responsible for keeping the Pandemic going. So now we can blame those who for whatever reason did not get vaccinated. The idea of a "Vaccine Passport" is a convenient way to identify the non-vaccinated and exclude them from society. Or just to show plain hostility towards them. Again, the messaging sets up the conflict, it seems almost by design. Or maybe Public Health officials didn't think it through. The simple message that would encourage harm reduction (i.e. prevent the spread of the virus) would be: if you get vaccinated you are protected to a high degree especially from becoming seriously ill from COVID.

Where this conflict will become the strongest is in our schools. Right now, the vaccines have not been approved for use in those under 16yrs old but clinical trials are currently ongoing for that age

group. I have a hunch that at some point, probably by next school year there will be emergency use approval for children. And then what? Well, we will be hearing things like, "I won't teach in the classroom if all the children are not vaccinated". A vaccine that has been authorized for emergency use is still experimental and cannot by law be mandated like the MMR childhood vaccine. But that won't stop the conflict. Again, the logic is skewed: I am only protected if you get the vaccine rather than I am protected by getting the vaccine. But how about if we all get the vaccine? Aren't we all protected then? Probably but a 100% vaccine rate won't happen for a variety of reasons.

Every person has the freedom of conscience to decide for themselves whether to get the vaccine or not and whether to have their children vaccinated or not. Whether it is because of a medical concern (personal health issues, uncertainty how the vaccine affects women of child bearing age, uncertainty how it affects children or having natural immunity from having had the virus) or an ethical concern (use of aborted fetal tissue in the testing and/or production of the vaccine) every person has the right to make a prudential decision and does not have to advertise their decision. Which means we do not need to argue about whether *someone else* should get the vaccine. Use all the information you have to make your best decision and live with it. We don't need to poke our nose masked or unmasked into anyone else's health choices.

Get ready, COVID Conflict Round II is underway. Resist getting caught up in it. Respect each other's choices, don't chomp on the apple of hostility and anger. And pray that we soon experience life "Beyond the Pandemic Thunderdome".

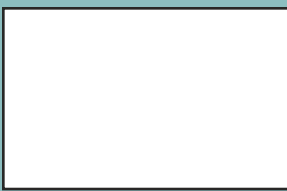

PS: The Pandemic has brought to the fore the issue of the use of aborted fetal tissue in vaccine development and manufacturing that has been going on for a long time and not just with the latest COVID vaccines but many other vaccines that are in regular use. The US Conference of Bishops is asking us all to contact the Pharmaceutical Companies that manufacture vaccines and ask them to stop using fetal tissue from aborted fetuses so that vaccines are both safe and ethical keeping with the demands of human dignity.

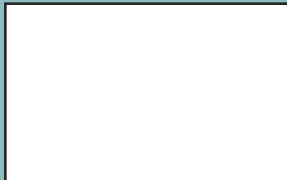
