

Our readings today remind us that our God is a tender and loving God.

In our Gospel, Jesus heals an ill child. An anxious and loving father sought after Jesus so that his daughter might be cured of her illness. As Jesus was traveling to heal her, they got word that the daughter had died. In that deeply painful moment, a moment no parent wants to experience, Jesus turned and said, "Do not be afraid; just have faith."

Recall a moment when you felt like you hit rock bottom. Maybe you received devastating news, someone died, you lost your job, you were fighting addiction, or you were suffering mentally, spiritually or physically. Maybe you are living that moment or maybe that moment is yet to come.

In that time, imagine Jesus looking at you and saying, "Do not be afraid; just have faith." Remember this verse. May it bring you peace and comfort. Recall that in our First Reading, God does not rejoice in our suffering and death. He rejoices in our faith and our trust in His glorious plan for our lives.

Whether we are healed like the little girl in our Gospel in this life, or we carry our suffering with us until we reach the next, if we remain faithful, Jesus will one day say to us, "Little girl or little boy, I say to you, arise!"


Today, let us reflect on how much our Good and Gracious God loves us. Remember that whatever we are suffering in this life, do not be afraid, God is right there with us.

BUILDING OUR ADORATION MUSCLE

Dear Friends,

If you have seen that my smiles have broadened these days, you are correct. Why? Well, this is because the long-awaited Perpetual Adoration Chapel construction is now underway as you have probably seen. This project is dear to my heart as it is in many of yours, I am sure. Yes, for many months, we have longed for, prayed fervently and battled with mundane procedures to reach this moment. Now that the construction is underway with its completion in sight, I would like to shift our attention to another very important aspect for which this Chapel is precisely being constructed, which is ADORATION. It is now time to begin building our "Adoration Muscle" as one of my staff members fondly refers to this spiritual exercise. But before beginning to build this muscle, allow me to briefly remind you of what Adoration is.

As I might have told you in other fora before, Adoration refers to spending a silent moment in prayer and reflection in the presence of Christ exposed in the form of a host in the monstrance or hidden in the tabernacle. Perpetual Adoration means that we have the opportunity to do this Adoration twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week. In order to achieve this spiritual exercise in an uninterrupted manner, individuals ("adorers") usually make a commitment to take turns being there around the clock. We are going to work out the modalities for signing up for this purpose as we get closer to the completion of our project.

I am pleased to note that here in our Parish, some steps have already been taken towards building this adoration muscle. For instance, every Tuesdays and Thursdays, we have one hour of Adoration also known as Holy Hour soon after the 6.30am Mass. On Wednesdays, we have a full day beginning with Exposition soon after the 8.30am Mass and concluding with Benediction at 6.00pm. In addition, every First Fridays, we have overnight Adoration beginning soon after the 7.00pm Mass concluding before the 8.00am Mass on Saturday morning. Plans are under way to extend more overnight opportunities in the coming months as we prepare for the completion of the construction in a couple of months' time. We shall also be inviting some speakers well versed with Eucharistic Adoration to prepare us to embrace this awesome opportunity. It is my hope that all these efforts will contribute towards building and strengthening our adoration muscles so that when our chapel is finally completed, we will be better prepared to use it as it is intended.

In the meantime, due to the construction going on, we shall be temporarily relocating our Wednesday and overnight Adorations to the Holy Family Room which is located on the southern part of our parish office until further notice. For more information on this and on the progress with the construction, watch this space!
