

LITURGY AND WORSHIP

INSTRUCTIONS ON THE RECEPTION OF THE PRECIOUS BLOOD By Joseph Malzone

On Sunday, September 15th, the Distribution of the Precious Blood will be reintroduced at masses in a phased rollout, beginning at the 9am and 11am masses. As discussed in previous articles about the Precious Blood, one does not need to consume both species of the Blessed Sacrament (Body and Blood separately) to receive all of Christ; he is completely present in either species. If, however, you wish to receive the Precious Blood, please follow the instructions below.

The Precious Blood will be distributed at two locations in the church: one for each half of the church, split down the center aisle. If you are receiving the Precious Body from either the center aisle where the Priest is distributing Holy Communion, or if you are receiving from the side aisle where a lay person Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion is assisting with the distribution, you can receive the Precious Blood at a small table with a white tablecloth in between each of those aisles where an Extraordinary Minister will be standing and distributing the Precious Blood.

- Approach this table and stand in front of it, not to the side of the table, so you are directly facing the Extraordinary Minister. If there is another person already at the table, please form a line to each side of the table along the curve of the white stone Sanctuary floor, until it is your turn to receive the Precious Blood.
- Once it is your turn to receive, and you are directly in the middle of the front of the table, the Extraordinary Minister will raise the chalice and say, "The Blood of Christ." You in turn respond, "Amen." After saying Amen, they will hand the chalice to you.
- When being handed the chalice, please always hold it with two hands: one hand underneath it, holding the base, and the other hand near the top rim. The Extraordinary Minister will be holding the chalice in the middle by the stem.
- The Precious Blood contained within the chalice is Jesus himself, so we want to ensure not even the smallest droplet of His blood falls. Please be very careful when handling the chalice.
- After taking hold of the chalice, take a small sip of the Precious Blood. This is not a "drink" from the chalice like you would take with a normal beverage. This is just a ritual sip, enough just to taste.
- After taking a sip, carefully hand the chalice back, ensuring you do not let go until the Extraordinary Minister has taken hold of the chalice.
- Then, turn around 180 degrees and walk back to your pew via the aisle directly in line with the chalice table.

SEPTEMBER: THE MONTH OF STEWARDSHIP IN OUR PARISH

Dear Friends,

For the past five weeks, our liturgy focused on the Bread of Life Discourse from St. John's Gospel, Chapter 6. However, beginning this Sunday till the end of the month, our Sunday liturgy will shift focus on Stewardship. You may recall that for several months in the past, I spoke about and wrote articles on stewardship. I am convinced therefore, that stewardship is by now not a new concept to our parish. Moreover, in trying to understand better our parish's past, I found out that our parish was so heavily involved with stewardship that it was, at one time, considered a model stewardship parish, especially under Fr. John Bonavitacola. This is what I hope our parish will become under my leadership because I personally also believe in stewardship. However, I also believe that to achieve this objective, we must have a correct understanding of what stewardship is and the spirituality it is built on.

In a past article, I pointed out that, understood correctly, stewardship is our recognition that whatever we have is a gift from God meant to be received gratefully, developed diligently with increase, and shared generously with our neighbors. We do this practically by, intentionally and consistently, offering of our time, talent, and treasure to God through our parish community. Our personal involvement in our parish's life through sharing generously our time, talent and treasure will define what our parish will be like. To deepen our understanding further on what stewardship is, however, the following will be the focus of our homilies:

- This weekend, September 1st will introduce us to what stewardship is.
- September 8th will focus on stewardship of Time.
- September 15^{th} will be on the stewardship of Talent
- September 22nd will focus on Treasure

September 29th will be our commitment weekend where I will ask you to commit your time, talent and treasure to the service of our parish. I now invite you to join me in praying our parish's stewardship prayer which contains, according to me, all the ingredients of what a faithful stewardship parish should embrace:

> My parish is composed of people like me I help make it what it is It will be friendly if I am It will be holy if I am Its pews will be filled if I help fill them It will do great work if I work It will be prayerful if I pray It will make generous gifts to many causes if I am a generous giver It will bring others into worship if I invite and bring them in It will be a place of loyalty and love, of fearlessness and faith. of compassion, charity, and mercy, if I, who make it what it is, am filled with these same things Therefore, with the help of God, I will dedicate myself to the task of being All the things that I want my parish to be.
