LITURGY AND WORSHIP

FAITH OF OUR FATHERS By Joseph Malzone

While I was in Italy, we celebrated Mass in the Catacombs of Rome, surrounded by the tombs of the early Christians, as well as by where some of the early Popes used to be buried. There were buried martyrs, clergy, families, and children; all Christians who lived the faith even through persecution. We celebrated Mass in a similar way to these early Christians, who celebrated the Mass atop the tombs of the Martyrs, sometimes even becoming martyrs themselves in the process. Even through the centuries of time that have passed between then and now, we share the same faith as the faith of our forefathers.

One of the reasons Mass is still celebrated atop a large, rectangular, solid table is that the altar is both physically and symbolically a tomb of a martyr for the faith, so we too celebrate in the same manner as our fathers in faith. The altar is a visual call-back to a tomb, and embedded within the altar are relics, pieces of bones, of a martyr, so they are with us.

We are custodians of this faith and tradition of those who have gone before us, many giving their very blood to defend our Lord and His Church. So as custodians, we are called to joyfully inherit, protect, and then hand on the unadulterated faith and tradition to future generations. We celebrate the Mass as has been handed on to us from generations before, understanding that the Sacred Liturgy is a physical and spiritual connection to the Church throughout the world and throughout the ages; through it we have in our very presence every Christian, including our own grandparents, who have gone before us and entered the eternal Kingdom.

Sistine Chapel

The centuries-old chapel adorned with Michaelangelo's frescoes has been the site of every papal election since 1878.

It's Marble floor is covered with wood. The windows and doors are shut as the Master of Papal Liturgical Ceremonies exclaims, "Extra omnes!" ("Everybody else, out!")

A sweep is performed for electronic devices, even on the electors.

Cardinal Electors

Placing a hand on the Gospels, each one swears to uphold the rules and secrecy of the conclave. Any communication with people outside is forbidden. They may not receive messages or news.

Cardinals under the age of 80 when the see became vacant may vote in the conclave. There are 135 eligible cardinals at this time.

Ballots and Voting

Votes are handwritten and cast individually into special urns. The top of the ballot reads "Eligo in Summun Pontificem" ("I elect as the Supreme Pontiff").

Ballots are counted by three "scrutineers." The work is checked by three "revisers." The ballot counters and verifiers are chosen by lot at the start of the conclave.

One round of voting is expected the first day. Each day after, two votes are taken in the morning and two votes in the afternoon until a successful vote. Should the conclave extend longer than 4 days, the electors will spend additional time in prayer and discussion before voting resumes.


A two-thirds majority is required to elect the new pope.

"Habemus Papam"

The one who is elected is asked if he accepts the election as pope. If he accepts, he chooses the name he will take. From the central balcony of St. Peter's basilica, the senior cardinal deacon proclaims, "Habemus papam!" (We have a pope!"), and announces his name. The new pontiff appears on the balcony and imparts his first papal blessing.
